In her lovely song was saying

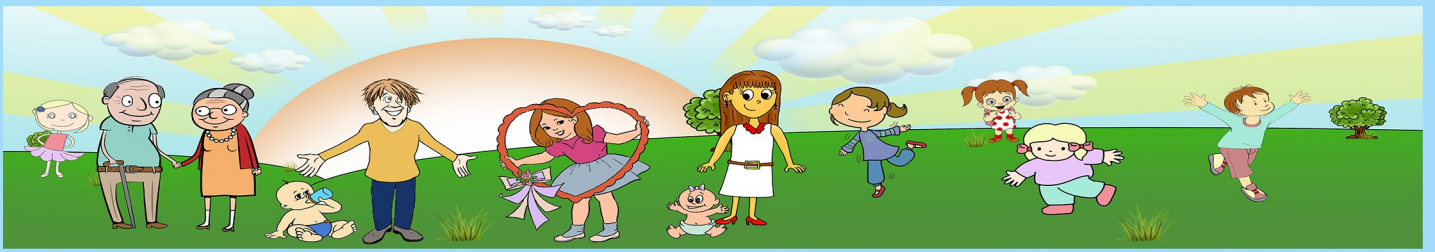
CHOIRS : **Goodnight, goodnight
